# **CODE OF CONDUCT**

- 1. This reunion weekend is meant for the Old Boys of S. Thomas' College at Gurutalawa who are members of the STCG OBA. As such, entry to the school premises will be strictly on the OBA membership card or proof of been registered as a member of the OBA. If any old boy who is not yet a member of the STCG OBA and wishes to attend the reunion weekend, he must be introduced and recommended by a classmate who is a member and must submit an application for membership with the required fee (Rs.1,500/-) at the point of entry. Please note, however, that participation at the Annual General Meeting will only be open to paid-up members of the STCG OBA.
- 2. A coupon will be issued to all those who purchase the ticket on paying Rs.7,500/- for the entire weekend and the holding of this coupon throughout the weekend will be mandatory and no participant will be allowed into the Dormitory & Dining Hall without the ticket. Separate tickets will be issued for Lunch /Dinner on 16<sup>th</sup> Saturday 2018.
- 3. Meal hours stipulated by the executive committee must be strictly observed, as food will not be available thereafter.

# Dress Code - AGM & Annual Reunion Dinner will be FORMAL or NATIONAL.

- 4. Drivers will be given separate accommodation and will not be permitted in the Dormitories.
- 5. CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC SPIRITS AND ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE SCHOOL PREMISES IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED
- 6. You are reminded to comply with the security arrangements initiated by the Headmaster, with reference to the reunion weekend and in the event of unruly behavior, the security officers have been instructed to remove the concerned member / members from the premises.

#### **FORMALITIES**

1. Participants must confirm their attendance in advance to facilitate the accurate meal count and information to the college kitchen.

- 2. Old Boys who are not yet members of the STCG OBA are requested to obtain membership before the reunion weekend.
- 3. If a member wishes to bring a non Thomian to attend the OBA Celebrations he will have to obtain prior written approval from the executive committee and the member should honor the decision of the Executive Committee.

The intention is to allow some contribution to be made to the College Development Fund from this levy.

#### **COLLEGE DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS FEB 2018- FEB 2019**

Ex CO is happy to place on record that the OBA successfully completed the following projects undertaken.

#### 1) Painting of Class Room Furniture: approx cost Rs 80,000/-

On a request made by Headmaster, OBA Ex CO members donated the entire quantum of paint (120 ltrs Enamel) required 30to paint chairs and tables in all the class rooms.

#### 2) 35 Seater - School Bus. - Rs. 4,000,000/-

The commitment undertaken by the OBA in 2017 to gift a school bus to College was successfully achieved. A Brand New Ashok Leyland 35 seater bus worth Rs 4,500,000/=.The OBA procured the bus for Rs. 4,000,000/- and thanks to the Senior Vice President who negotiated and obtained a discount of Rs. 500,000/- on the quoted price.

Our most sincere thank to all those who contributed by way of donations and a very special thanks to Prabahath Jayasundera's commitment to raise 50% of the total cost. A sum of Rs 2,000,000/- was collectively donated as follows - Prabath Jayasundera Rs 650,000/-, Ranjith Gunaratne Rs. 650,000/-, Samantha Perera Rs. 500,000/-, B.S.R. Fernando Rs 200,000/-

Prior to handing over the bus the OBA got it Registered, Insured and Licensed it under the College Name and delivered with a full tank of fuel.

#### 3) Play Ground Project for Primary School Students - Stage I - approx cost Rs. 1,600,000/-

Since the school introduced the primary classes from Kindergarten to Grade five a couple of decades ago, there was this need for a play ground facility within the 45 acre main campus specially for the Primary School Students to play Football, Hockey, Rugby and for Athletics.

The OBA along with the College took up the task in July 2018 - turning out the abandon tennis courts and its surrounding area to set up 125 Meter X 80 Meter playground with minimal impact to the environment.

Stage I of the project - Preparation of Contour Plans, Evaluating the Contractors, Clearing the site, mobilizing machinery for Earthwork, Leveling and Compacting.

We are extremely thankful to Anil Gammampila who spontaneously responded by donating a sum of Rs. 1,000,000/- to get the project of the ground. Our sincere thanks also to the following well wishers Kavinda Nanayakkara /CTC Rs. 300,000/-, Arujuna Rajawasam Rs. 100,000/- for their donations and to all others who generously contributed.

The following members Chrishantha Jayawardhana - Chartered Surveyor & Developer, Uditha Wijesena Chartered Civil Engineer and Krishantha Somanayake - Chartered Architect generously contributed their valuable professional time, expertise and resources to Plan, Design, to Execute and successfully complete the Stage I work by December 2018.

Stage II will be to Turf the grounds, Install a Sprinkler System and Fencing the boundary. We kindly look forward to your valuable contributions by way of professional expertise, funding, supply of material requirements, labour or machinery that may be required or any other product or services that you may be able to contribute.

#### 4) OLD BOYS FELLOWSHIP DINNER - approx Profit Rs. 350,000/-

Our main objectives were to -

- (1) Felicitate our living founder members of the OBA who are now in between the ages 80 to 90 years. We managed to locate about twelve living founder members and invited them to be our guests of honor. Only three of them could be present M/s Arthur Perera, B. Munasinghe and Bandula Wanigasekera.
- (2) To be a fund raiser for College Development by to completing the Stage Two of the Playground Project.
- (3) To ceremonially handover the gift of the School Bus.

On 10th November 2018 we held the Fellowship Dinner at "SUMMERFIELDS", almost 300 old boys & well wishes participated and raised approx Rs. 350,000/-.
